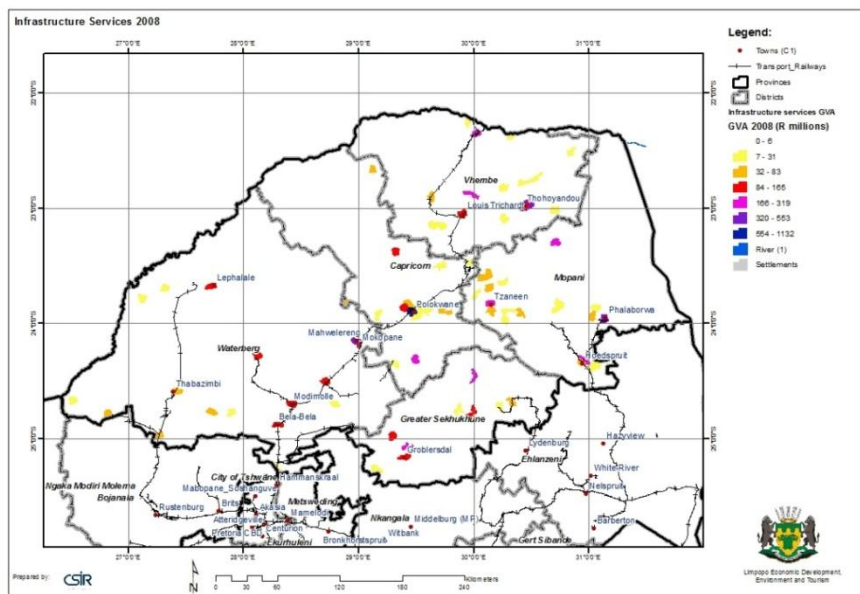


THEME:**INFRASTRUCTURE SERVICES GVA,
2008****CATEGORY:****ECONOMIC****Infrastructure services**

The rationale for this theme is that it describes all the engineering and other infrastructure services that are demanded both by households (for their residential and related activities) and by business enterprises. There are also a number of important “backward linkages” with, and impacts on the natural resource sector (sometimes seen as providing so-called *ecosystem services*).

Infrastructure services GVA

In 2004, the volume of economic activity in this sector grouping was R177.5 billion (GVA) (source: Global Insight’s 2004 Regional Economic Focus). This includes the following categories (listed in terms of the Standard Industrial Classification codes):

- SIC 41: Electricity, gas, steam and hot water supply
- SIC 42: Collection, purification and distribution of water
- SIC 50: Construction
- SIC 71-72: Land and water transport
- SIC 73-74: Air transport and transport supporting activities
- SIC 75: Post and telecommunications
